I hate to sound old, but it's hard to believe we are writing our last prayer letter this year, it sure has flown by! We are thankful for your prayers and financial support that enable us to serve the Lord in Nauru.

We are please to report the salvation of Crynsia and Larko. Crynsia, Bro Simpson's cousin, was saved October 7th. She and her children have been coming to Sunday Evening services some, and had raised her hand about salvation, and Christie was able to lead her to the Lord. Larko is the 13 year old son of Washington and Evalina who was saved on the 27th October after the morning service. He had raised his hand about salvation at different times, but this Sunday I spoke to him after the service and was able to lead him to the Lord. Larko is a great kid, he is crazy about aussie rules footy, he is faithful to Teen Time, Church and Men's Breakfast and boy can he eat! Please pray these two as they grow in the Lord, and that other teens will see their need of a Saviour.

The last Sunday evening service in November, we had something we have never had before in 5 years of Church services...MUSIC! Bro Simpson, who we mentioned joined the church with his family last letter, has been learning to play the Guitar to accompany our singing of hymns. We sung two hymns that evening with music which was great, and he is working to get better at others so he can play on Sunday Mornings also. We have been praying for a church musician for a while and are thankful for Bro Simpson's willingness to be used of the Lord in this way.

We had our last men's breakfast for the year in November. We had 7 attend and did some planning towards Men's Breakfasts next year.

We are still unable to resume our bible study up at the Refuge Processing Center. Please pray with us that the Lord will open the door for this ministry again in his time.

Our missions giving continues to be above the \$132 a month commitment, \$252.65 for October and \$185.20 for November.

We are currently without our large air conditioner and our washing machine, and waiting for parts for each to get to Nauru. Regular blackouts and power issues seem to take their toll on our appliances. Thank you for your faithful support that enables us to take care of these needs as they arise.
