Happy New Year, from the McGeorge family and the International Baptist Church of Nauru. We thank you for your prayers and financial support through this last year, we could not be here, for the Lord, without you!



On December 15th we had our kids Christmas Program (see photo), Dinner on the Grounds and an afternoon service. Our Kids did a great job, we sang “Joy to the World” in Nauruan in the afternoon service and read the Christmas Story.

On Thursday 19th we did our “Coloured Lights of Nauru Wagon Tour” where we pick everyone up, and do a few laps of the island looking at Christmas lights; the Kids really love it! We had a few visitors this year, and gave a devotion before we stopped for ice cream. We collected ballots with votes for the best lights and gave prizes to the homes on behalf of the church for their show of “Christmas Spirit”.

We started out the New Year with our 5th Anniversary of the church on the 5th of January. Our theme this year is “5 years preaching the Book, The Blood and the Blessed Hope”. I asked some questions about the history of our church, in our afternoon service and our people seemed to really enjoy, especially when they were the answer to the question! One of our families, Junior and Lisa are off to continue their studies in Fiji for a few years, so we sent them off that day also.

One of our ladies who is a nurse at the hospital let me know there was a man who wanted someone to visit him.
