We started to have a few men’s breakfasts this year, in an effort to teach and train faithful men according to 2 Tim 2:2. We sing, have prayer request, a devotion and also a practical teaching time. In August, Tyler, our Taiwanese Vet, taught about how to take care of pet dogs which was very helpful. 6th Grade boys through men come to the breakfast and we have a good time of food and fellowship. Please Pray that these times will be helpful to train men and future generations of male leadership in the Church.

We were saddened to see Tyler leave Nauru and go back to Taiwan at the end of August. He started coming to services while we were on furlough, at the invitation of Bro Paine and was a blessing. We had a sendoff for him the last Sunday in August. We had cake and gave him gifts to remember us by. He has not made a profession of faith, but we trust the seed of the word of God has been sown and that it will not return void. We hope he will get involved in one of the Baptist Churches (that we gave him information about) that are near his home in Taichung, Taiwan. Please pray for his salvation and church attendance back in Taiwan.



The 2nd of September we were able to get our 1995 Turbo Diesel Toyota Landcruiser out of the shipping container. We were blessed to only be charged 10% import duty as opposed to the 25% we expected to pay! It pulls the wagon with ease and everyone enjoys riding in the A/C when they get the chance. Thankyou so much to those who gave to meet this need. It is a great blessing to have a newer and more reliable vehicle for the ministry.

We had Fathers Day the 1st Sunday in September and the men went to lunch together which was a good time. On the 25th of September was National Youth day, a Public holiday and so we had a church BBQ at the beach. We had a great time of food and fellowship.

The last Sunday in September was 5th Sunday Fellowship, where we had a morning service, dinner on the grounds and then an afternoon service. We had a 43 in attendance, among whom was a family who joined the church.

We are pleased to report that our missions commitment continues to do well, the church committed \$132 a month and since then we have had \$224, \$214, and \$280 come in for the months since our missions conference. Please pray this will continue.
