We had a great Easter time, with a Church BBQ on Good Friday a nd Easter Egg Hunt and Church Photo on Easter Sunday.


On Sunday April 27th we were saddened by the news that Chris (who I mentioned in the last letter) passed away, and the family asked if I would preach his funeral on Monday. Having never preached a funeral before I was abit unsure of things, but it went very well. We were able to meet with the family before the service, and they were very receptive to the Gospel. I was able to share with them how Chris came to trust in Christ, and several of his family raised their hands about being interested in salvation. Unexpectedly to me, the President of Nauru, was also present at the funeral. What an



opportunity arranged of the Lord to be able preach to the President! (one of the many blessings of living and ministering on a Small Island Nation. Several of Chris's nieces have been coming to Sunday school since the funeral and we hope to be able to reach others in his family in the future.

May 1st the Lord opened the door for us to resume our Bible studies with the Assylum seekers stationed on Nauru. Most of the men are Iranian, but we have also had some from Sri Lanka, and Cameroon. The going is slow and their limited English and my non-existent Farsi make it difficult, but they enjoy learning from the Word. Please pray for the Salvation and growth of these men, especially Millard and Valli who have not missed since we started.

May 6th we were able to get a small crane up to our place to move a 20ft shipping container into place so we can transform it into a Sunday School Room. We were thankful the Crane work was free of Charge! We had a few Church Work days to get the container painted and I was able to cut a hole in the side of the container to mount a door. Still more work to do, but it's getting there, and the kids love it.
