In December we finished out the year with the Kids Christmas Program, and "Christmas Lights of Nauru Wagon Tour". The Kids did a great job quoting scriptures from memory telling the Christmas Story, and then on the wagon tour we stopped for ice cream, a devotion and voted for the best Christmas lights and Bro Simpson and I gave the winners a gift of rice from the church for their show of "Christmas Spirit". It was a good time of fellowship and several visitors also came along for the ride!

I always joke with people on Nauru how you can tell that it is Christmas on Nauru, as we have No Petrol, No Power and Rain! In spite of Petrol shortages and rationing and Power outages and wet weather, we still had a Merry Christmas on our "Pleasant Island".

The first Sunday of the New Year we celebrated the 6th anniversary of International Baptist Church Nauru, and had Dinner on the grounds and questions about the history of the church, with Candy rewards!



Later in January we had our annual Men and Boys Campout, which was more of a "Wash-out" than campout this year. At 3:30am Saturday Morning it started pouring rain and didn't stop. Everyone had good attitudes in spite of the rain, and the boys enjoyed catching, cooking and eating their own fish!

On the last Sunday of January in the Morning Service we preached about "Real Faith" from 2 Tim 1:5, which is our theme for the year, and in the evening service we had our annual church business meeting, gave a report on the Church Finances and passed out church calendars for the year. We are looking forward to Revival Services in March with Pastor Frank Wood, and Missions Conference in August with Bro W.L Smith.
