God has certainly been very good to us in our years on Nauru

### 2015 Review

In January we have our Annual Church Business meeting, to give a Ministry and Financial report on the outgoing year. Highlights of the year were our first Revival Meeting in March, with Pastor Frank Wood, and our Missions conference in August with W.L. Smith.

We had 32 first time visitors for the year, 2 saved and 2 baptised, gave \$2,238.60 to Missions and added Bro Smith to our missions family for financial Support. We averaged 25.8 for Sunday Morning, 9.7 for Sunday Evening and 5.3 for Thursday night Bible Study. Our highest days of the year were 46 for the Sunday after Revival and 54 for the last night of Missions Conference.

We are looking forward to our furlough this year, reporting back to our eastern supporting churches, and spending time with family. We are thankful that Leo and Cathy Paine are able to "Stand in the Gap" for us again in our absence.
