It has been a busy few months on our little Island.

March 15th-18th was our churches first revival meeting with Pastor Frank Wood. This is Pastor Wood and Wanda Second visit to Nauru. The last time they were here was in May of 2011 for the organization of the church.

We had great services for the revival, with good attendance and quite a few visitors. We had high attendances of 37 on Sunday morning and 31 on Tuesday night and two of our visitors Dillon and Bernice were saved the Saturday after revival! Please pray for them as they grow in Grace that the Lord will continue to work in their lives.

The Sunday after Revival was the Send-Off for Pastor and Wanda as they began the long journey home, we had 46 in attendance and 4 visitors, dinner on the grounds and an afternoon service.

Our people were very thankful for the visit from the Woods. Christie and I enjoyed the fellowship, and the boys really enjoyed their time with their grandparents, and neither of them got sick until they were about to fly out! On the funny side, the two Sundays Pastor was here we had flat tyres on the Wagon.

We had 2 in 7days with Pastor Frank "Flat Tyre" Wood, and I've had 2 in 7 years before that, and none since...so it was obviously Preachers fault...and all our people agreed, and gave him a hard time for it! ☺

We also had Diesel Shortages while pastor and Wanda were here (for the first time in our 7 years on Nauru ☺) but nothing that ended up hindering our special services, Praise the Lord!

We also Baptised Jamie the last Sunday in March, who had been saved recently but not followed the Lord in Believers Baptism. We were on our way to Baptise in the ocean the week before when the flat tyre struck...so we postponed it till the following week.
