Dear Praying Friends,

What a busy last few months we've had here on Nauru with plenty to be thankful for and lots of news to share.

### **2nd Missions Conference, June 12th-15th with Rowe Family to PNG**

We were very excited to have the Rowe family with us for our second Missions Conference. We really enjoyed their fellowship, and they were a blessing to our church family in their Preaching, teaching, singing and testimonies. In our previous missions year we gave \$2,732.25 July 2013-May 2014 with 8 making missions Commitments totaling \$132/month. This conference we had 11 making missions commitments totaling \$245/Month. We also were able to take on the Rowe Family for support as our missionaries to PNG, they are our 2nd missionary family.



### **Refugee Visitors**

We had 9 first time visitors in June, most of whom were Refugees who have been resettled into the Nauru community from the 2 Regional Processing camps located on Nauru. We are excited about the opportunity to reach these with the Gospel, most are Iranian, and have had limited exposure to Christianity. Some are Christian who fled their home countries from persecution. For our July Teen Time we had 15, over 1/2 of which were Iranian! We have been able to give invitations, tracts, discipleship material and 3 Bibles so far in their own language (Farsi/Persian), please pray with us that we will be able to reap a harvest as the Word of God goes forth.

### **More Refugee Visitors**

Before the riots at one of the Processing Camps last June we were regularly having some of the men come to Sunday Morning services. Since the riots, we have not had any back, but they are in the process of approving the Asylum Seekers to attend our Sunday morning services again. We have weekly Bible Studies with some of the men from Camp 2 (all of whom are Iranian), most of whom have a Salvation testimony and desire to follow the Lord in Believers Baptism, which we would be able to do if they were able to come to Church. Please pray that this paperwork and approval will process quickly and we will be able to have these men and other visitors from the 2 regional processing camps to our services.
