Paul and Martha Daku Visit

We were thankful to have Paul and Martha Daku visit Nauru for a few weeks in October. They have been missionaries to Fiji for 20yrs, where he Pastors the International Baptist Church of Lautoka, Fiji. They came to Nauru to hold down the fort for us so we could go to Australia for a few weeks for my dad's 70th Birthday, to catch up with family, go to eye doctor and dentist appointments, and restock a few necessary supplies. We enjoyed our time away, and the Daku's did well on Nauru coping with rain and power outages and cranking our diesel generator! There were visitors in most services, and several people trusted the Lord during their time on island. We had a sendoff lunch and afternoon service on the 24th of October, and everyone was thankful for their visit.



Naomi gets Baptised

Taratoa is a lady from Kiribati who has lived on Nauru for many years, and she has been attending our services for a few years. Our church renamed her Naomi, because no one could pronounce her name (even those who speak her language! :), and they use to just call her "the old lady". Recently we found out that she wanted to be Baptised, and after visiting with her, she said she had trusted the Lord sometime on her own when she first started coming to our services (pacific islands can be particularly shy at times). So after the morning service on Nov 23rd we went to Gabab channel and Baptised Naomi into our church family. We are thankful for the Lord's working in the hearts of our people, even though many times outwardly we would never know! Her sister is a member of Tarawa Baptist Church in Kiribati, where Missionary Joel Daku, and his family are serving. They are our closest missionary neighbours in the pacific 458miles(738km) away.
