We are thankful to the Lord for his safety (on our 50,000 miles of furlough travels) and blessings, and for every church that allowed us to visit and report on the work in Nauru. We were treated far greater than we deserve, by the Lord and His Churches and we are thankful for your interest, encouragement, prayer and financial investment in us and the work in Nauru.

We are also thankful for the opportunities to present our ministry in a few new churches, and those who have added us to their missionary family. It sure is a blessing to represent you in Nauru!

October took us to Oklahoma, Indiana and Florida to report to supporting churches and be part of alumni days at HBBC. We also gained a new supporting church, Bible Baptist Church of Prairie Creek, Selma, Indiana, Pastor Doug Keppel.

November, We were also able to be part of a Missions Conference at Lakewood Baptist Temple, Lakewood, Washington, via FaceTime with Pastor Josh Knouf and the congregation. We answered some questions and mentioned a few needs we had they took up a special offering for us of \$1500. It was such a great blessing that we are prayerfully considering doing all of our furlough travels next time via FaceTime! ;)
