



Dear Praying Friends,

We hope this letter finds you well. These are the notable occurrences in the last 2 months of ministry on Nauru.

- Most Sunday morning church attendances were in the 20's, some high, some low.
- I have enjoyed Preaching through the book of Acts on Sunday Mornings. The book is very pointed about the need of personal evangelism which is a need for every missionary and helpful for our people and an area which we all need to continue to grow in.
- June and July Missions totals were \$219.70 and \$267.15 which is great.
- Lau and Christian were two Tongan visitors who came in June. Lau works every other Sunday in his schedule at the Bakery, so we try to encourage him to come whenever he can.
- Tike and his girlfriend Xenia have come several weeks in the last few months, pray for them and their spiritual needs. Tike's mum is Mafa, one of our members.
- Continue to pray for Maria and Julie, both seem to be doing well and growing in the Lord. We have not seen Jetta or Kero for a while as they have both been working on Sundays.
- The last Sunday in July was 5th Sunday fellowship and dinner on the grounds together after the morning service. We had great food and fellowship.
- Our missionary neighbours in Kiribati Joel and Brooke Daku sent us some I-Kiribati John and Romans which we have been giving to Kiribati people on Nauru.
- The island is gearing up for the Pacific Islands Forum in a few months – road fixing (which is a rare thing on our island), Hotel addition, remodeling, building and beautification are going on all around the island. There has been a lot of work done up near our house, where the church meets. Clearing two huge fig trees that had overgrown the area, and clearing and preparing the area to be the new state house residence for the president. When its all said and done, we will have the opportunity to be the president's neighbour!
- Christie made a quick surprise visit back to the states for her nephew's high school graduation and to surprise to her mother and grandmother. She was in the states 2 weeks, and had a great time with family. The Boys and I survived without her for almost 3 weeks, but only just! Everything and everyone does better when she is around!
- Gideon turned 6 on 28th July. Christie is not so excited that her baby is 6, but he is lots of fun and we had a great time celebrating his birthday playing baseball and going for a swim and celebrating with friends.
