Though we are not in the same class of missionary as William Carey, we do feel a similar contentment in plodding along in the place where God has called us to serve. We are ever thankful for your prayers and support that enable us to plod along in Nauru.

It has been a wet start to the year, which has not been helpful for church attendance, but we are thankful for some good attendance Sundays recently with 36 in February and 31 in March. We had our annual business meeting in February and our average attendance was 25.3 Sunday morning and 8.3 Thursday evening Bible study (though we are not sure who the .3 is... We had 48 visitors for 2018 and our financial giving increased and missions stayed about the same.

We are thankful for the more faithful attendance of Frank and Mida and their two boys, Bruce and Danny. Please pray they will grow and increase for the Lord.

Julie has not been as faithful and interested as she was. While we were away the Smith's had opportunity to teach and speak with her and we believe she knows that she needs to be saved. Please pray that she will see her need of Christ.

March 25th our stuff arrived that we shipped from Australia in January and we have been busy around the house moving, replacing, fixing etc.

The boys are all doing well. Elijah turned 13 in March (how we have a teenager, we are not really sure, and Titus is 9 and Gideon 6.

We have talked with Leo and Cathy Paine who are in Zambia, filling in for a missionary, and they have agreed to fill in for us so we can take a furlough this November 2019-August 2020. This will be their 3rd "Tour of Duty" in Nauru. We are planning to visit our western supporting churches in Kansas, Nebraska, Texas, Oklahoma, Arizona, California, Washington, and Wyoming that we were unable to visit on our last furlough.
