Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

"The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will." Proverbs 21:1

I can't tell you exactly how long we have been praying and asking others, namely you, to pray for the registration of our church with the government of Nauru, and submitting paperwork...but it's been over 8 years, perhaps closer to 10 years.

It's one of those things that has been on the prayer list (and at the bottom of prayer letters;) longer than I can remember, and to be honest some times I wondered if things would ever work out for us to be a registered church on the island, so that we could legally lease or own land.

The new president of Nauru, Mr Lionel Aingimea, is a friend of mine from his previous term as a member of parliament. After a recent conversation with him I was contacted by one of his assistants about the status of the registration of the church. He encouraged us to resubmit our paperwork for registration of the church and that the new government was for the registration and recognition of new churches, which the previous governments were not.

After a meeting with the president on Friday 11th October and a cabinet meeting soon following we received a phone call at 8:30pm the following Thursday night after Bible study to inform us that the church had been recognised by the government of Nauru. **Praise the Lord for how He works! And thank you to those who have faithfully prayed for the registration of the church with the government of Nauru, your prayers have been answered!**

Leo and Cathy Paine arrived the 31st of October, and were with us for a great Sunday on the 3rd before we flew out. We accepted Frank and Mitta and their 3 boys into membership, and dedicated their new son Hedan Bagadouwe to the Lord. We had lunch together and enjoyed the fellowship with our Nauruan church family before flying out the next morning.

We enjoyed our time with family in Australia before driving down to Sydney, then flying to Hawaii. We had a great time as a family on the Big Island before flying back to Indiana.

We have been busy since we arrived, with Titus's 10th Birthday, and Thanksgiving and some vacation time with family. Other than that we are getting things ready to begin our furlough travels in January 2020.

News from Leo and Cathy is that things are going well in spite of some vehicle troubles, and church attendance has been great and the weather has been wet.

1. The work in Nauru to grow, have visitors and receive land.
2. Pray for Leo and Cathy Paine as they stand in the gap for us
3. Pray for our health and safety as we travel, and that we will be a blessing and encouragement to our supporting churches.
