Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

December is always a busy month in our home church, with Christmas Parties, the kids Christmas program, Christmas with the family, a church snow tubing trip and Watch-night service to see out the old year and in the new year. We were thankful to be part of it all, with some snow for the boys in Indiana. Any Christmas we are able to spend with family is special for us as missionaries, and 2019 was exceptionally good! We'd like to say a special thanks to those who sent special Christmas offerings to us this past year, they were much appreciated! We were also able to purchase a 2012 Honda Odyssey for our furlough travels, with the help of some handy men in our home church, we did the timing belt service, and installed a tow hitch and got it ready to hit the road. We went to the funeral of Don Chesher, Christie's great uncle in Middlebury, Indiana before heading towards Oklahoma.

We caught up with some supporting churches in Oklahoma and were able to attend the Church Planters Conference at HBBC. We really enjoyed the meeting and saw over \$530,000 raised towards church planting efforts in the USA.

We started a missions conference at Cornerstone Baptist Church in Phoenix, Arizona, but were all taking turns battling sickness and fever from Oklahoma. Finally by Sunday 26th Jan we were all well again. Sunday Night our whole family were spoiled rotten by many gifts from the Cornerstone Church family and we received a special gift of \$15,000 towards a newer van for the field! We have only just started raising funds for this need in the few churches we have reported back to, and already we have been overwhelmed by the response of great generosity of many so far. The vehicle purchase price of \$15,000USD has been raised, and we are well on the way towards the \$8000USD in shipping costs to get the vehicle from Japan to Nauru (via Fiji).
