Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

We hope this letter finds you well and making the best of the situation that you are facing in your life and ministry in your location.

To say we are living in strange days would certainly be an understatement!

This letter finds us back home in Indiana after our time out west. We are thankful for the church services and missions conferences we were able to be part of in California, Arizona, Kansas, Nebraska, and Iowa. We were able to report to 12 supporting churches and present our ministry in 6 new churches.

We were sorry to have to cancel meetings in Wyoming, Washington and Minnesota due to service restrictions from the Corona Virus.

We enjoyed our travels from the first of the year, but were glad to be back home among friends, family and church family, but only at the 6ft social distance of course ;) Our home church services are all live stream only due to county restrictions, but these have also enabled some church remodelling work to be done, which we were able to be part of.

We are thankful and amazed at the generosity of those who have given towards a newer vehicle for the field. The purchase price of \$15,000USD has been raised, and we are well on the way towards the \$8000USD in shipping costs to get the vehicle from Japan to Nauru(via Fiji).If you would like give towards this need you can do so via the GIBM in Sherman, Texas.

News from Nauru is that Leo and Cathy are well. The Government of Nauru has restricted travel to one flight every 2 weeks and all passengers are checked and quarantined for 2 weeks in an effort to keep the Corona virus out. So far so good, there have been no Covid-19 cases on Nauru. There had been normal island sickness going around, which had lowered attendance, but last Sunday they were back up to 34, with public service announcements about washing hands regularly with soap, and social distancing. We are very thankful for how things are going in our absence and for Leo and Cathy Paine standing in the gap for us!
