Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

Mark 6:31 And he said unto them, Come ye yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: for there were many coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat.

With quarantine restrictions for the state of Indiana for the month of April, I feel like we have no grounds to complain about a “lack of rest” this furlough from all the “coming and going”. We had to cancel or reschedule a few meetings, but we were able to visit Crookston, Minnesota via online Zoom meeting which worked out better than the 13hr drive plus the foot of snow they received the day before we were scheduled to be there! (We Tropical Wusses don’t function well in those conditions!) We were thankful to present our ministry to Pastor Hoiseth and Bible Baptist Church from our missions apartment in New Castle, Indiana.

By the time May rolled around we were a-bit stir crazy and ready to hit the road again, but with some restrictions lasting longer in some areas our 6 week trip to New Mexico and Texas ended up being reduced to 3 1/2 weeks in Texas only. During our trip we peached on the church porch in Fritch, Texas for a drive-in service and preached to an empty auditorium in Sherman Texas for a recorded Wednesday night service. To say “we ain’t never done furlough like that before” is a grammatically poor, yet true sentiment. We are glad to be meeting, in person, in church services again and enjoy the gathering together for worship, fellowship, and encouragement that can only come when we gather together.

We are thankful to report that the vehicle (\$15,000USD) and shipping costs (\$8,000USD) have been raised, by the generous giving of our supporting churches. We are thankful for the funds we have received, and the investment those who gave were willing to make in us and the ministry in Nauru.

News from Nauru is that Leo and Cathy are well and there is still no Coronavirus cases on island which is great! The Government of Nauru has recently received two Covid testing machines that means time in quarantine after arrival has shrunk from two weeks to 24hrs. News of this was music to our ears and an answer to prayer. Please pray that they will begin to add more flights to make it easier for Leo and Cathy to leave Nauru once we get back on island. We are very thankful for how things are going in our absence and for Leo and Cathy Paine standing in the gap for us!

1. The work in Nauru to grow, have visitors and receive land.
2. Pray for Leo and Cathy Paine as they stand in the gap for us
3. Pray for our health and safety as we travel, and that we will be a blessing and encouragement to our supporting churches.
