Dear praying friends,

Psalm 127:1 Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain.

December is always a busy month around church in Nauru, and 2020 was no exception. We had youth Christmas parties, ladies Christmas parties and the Kids Christmas program. We observed the Lord's Supper Tuesday 22nd December, this is the first time we have done this at Christmas time. Our family enjoyed a quiet Christmas on the island to wind up what had been a busy year with furlough travels, international travel and the added challenges of Covid Restrictions. We had a church fellowship dinner and game night on the 31st of December that finished well before the new year arrived.

January 24th in the PM service we had our annual business meeting. Business meetings are not the most exciting services per se, and ours is no exception, but they do cause us to pause and evaluate our ministry and finances which is a good thing. Due to the timing of our last furlough, this was a report on 2019 and 2020. We are pleased to report that the work is in great financial shape through the faithful giving of our people and we have seen some numerical growth to all services. Our high attendance for the year was 53, Sunday September 13th after we got out of Nauru quarantine, and the average Sunday AM attendance for 2020 was 33.8, Sunday PM was 15.2 and Thursday Bible study was 10.8, all improvements on 2019 numbers and the Tithe and missions for the two years was \$28,667.80 and \$6,783.35 which is great to see. In 2020 we saw 4 saved and 5 Baptised. We are thankful that the Lord is building His work here on Nauru, and that we are seeing growth among the faithful in financial giving. We know there is much more to His work than financial growth and numerical blessing, and we trust that the Spirit will continue to work in the other areas of their spiritual growth that are less easy to add up and give a yearly report on :)

We were able to be part of a Missions Conference with Bellingham Baptist Church, Bellingham, Washington, Pastor Josh Carter via Zoom meeting on Jan 7th. They were able to show our video presentation from our recent furlough and we answered some of their questions about life and ministry on Nauru. We enjoyed the opportunity to share our field with the church and be part of their "virtual conference". We are excited that they are partnering with us in the work with their prayers and finances, and they also gave a special offering towards our return to the field expenses which was a great blessing.
