McGeorge Prayer Letter August / September 2021

Dear praying friends,

Luke 1:37 For with God nothing shall be impossible.

We received an interesting email from our landlord informing us that she would like us to move out in the next 6 months (by February/March 2022). We were shocked by the news, but with some time to wrap our brains around the idea we are excited about what the future holds.

We announced it to our people last Thursday and told them to keep their ears out for any houses for rent and any places the church could meet.

We have lived at MQ11 since we arrived on the island in August of 2008, to say we are comfortable here is an understatement. We live here, we have a roofed area to have church outside our house, we have 2 20ft shipping containers on property (one storage, one Sunday school), the church has its own toilet, the situation has worked very well (though moving it all is a daunting task!) and the Lord has blessed and we are very thankful for our time here.

We have mentioned the need of church registration, and land for the church to build a permanent building and pastors house on since our very first church business meeting, but the limited options have not proved suitable for various reasons. For many years we were waiting on registration. Since Oct 2019 the church has been now registered with the government of Nauru, allowing us to lease or own land, but we are still waiting on land.

As of now we are praying for the Lord to open doors for a house for us to live in and a separate suitable place for the church to meet. We would like a large piece of land that could have both, but for them to be separate buildings. It does seem like a good time to separate our house from the church, and encourage our church members to take more responsibility and ownership of church related facilities that would not be "at Pastor's house." Please pray for the Lord's will to be accomplished, that He would open the right doors in where we live and where the church meets, and that he would give us wisdom to make good decisions regarding these situations. We have a few leads here and there to check out, and will let you know more as things become clearer.

Currently on Nauru there are lots of houses going up all over the island due to the Government housing scheme building houses on any available lands, or renovating older houses (like MQ11 built in 1949!) at no cost to the land owners. This means land is more scarce than normal on an 8 square mile island, but we know God is able! We are thankful that we serve a God to whom nothing is impossible and we are praying for him to work on our behalf. We ask that you would please remember these situations in prayer also.

Some Prayer Requests to Remember...

1. The work in Nauru to grow, have visitors and receive land.
2. Australian citizenship Paperwork for Titus and Gideon

Thank you once again for your prayers and support that enable us to continue to serve the Lord, and represent you in Nauru.
