McGeorge Prayer Letter December 2021 / January 2022
Dear praying friends,

Thank you for your prayers on our behalf! We are thankful that the Lord is working on our behalf to meet the needs of our family and ministry as we move ahead in an uncertain new year. It's just as well the Lord is in control of it all and we can completely trust in Him!

The new house is moving ahead! We have a full roof and full ceiling, most of the electrical run, concrete counter tops in the kitchen, 2/3 of the plastering done, most of the ceiling painted, 3 of 6 doors in. We have been doing all the painting ourselves so far, and are waiting on more work to be finished so we can keep plugging away. Please pray we can get a heavy excavator on site to remove the tops of pinnacles and clear more land for use. At this stage we have no level land for our two 20ft containers. We are meant to be out of our current house in Feb/March this year, so Lord willing by next letter we will be settled in! Pray for Tyke and his workers as they keep on moving ahead.

We had our annual business meeting in the PM service of Jan 23rd. Before the meeting we challenged our church workers to be prepared, responsible and professional in how they conduct themselves in regard to their ministry in the church. During the meeting we took on two new Missionaries (to support 4 in total) and increased our support from \$50 to \$100 per month. We also gave \$500 to two other missionaries who had financial needs for building projects. Financially the church is doing great with \$16,734.35 in Tithe and \$5843.85 in missions for 2021. We had 60 first time visitors most of whom came with church members which is a great blessing. Our attendance averages were 43 Sun AM, 17.5 Sun PM, 13.1 Thursday Bible Study, and 15.6 Youth Night all up from the 2020 averages which is great. We did not have any saved or baptised through the year and are praying that 2022 will be more fruitful in salvations as well as spiritual and numerical growth.

The last Sunday in January was our last Sunday service at our current location. Next Sunday we are planning to meet at a community hall in Meneng for at least Sunday services. By "Community Hall" I mean a concrete slab with a roof over it, no walls, no power, no toilets. All services at the Community hall are BYOS, bring your own seat :)! Sunday school will be back on the wagon like the good 'ole days before our Sunday school container. We are excited about the new location, and hope the lack of stairs will be a help to some who have struggled to attend. Please pray that our people will be faithful to the new location and that we will also have visitors as its right by the main road.

Some Prayer Requests to Remember...

1. The new house to be finished in time
2. The new Church meeting location to work well
3. The work in Nauru have visitors and grow numerically and spiritually

Thanks again for your prayers and support that enable us to continue to serve the Lord and represent you in Nauru. Please keep us in your prayers as we move into some very busy months ahead with working on the new house and moving. We are glad our boys are big enough to help and be useful in the move!

Thank you to all who gave us gifts for Christmas. It is a blessing to be remembered during the holiday season.
