McGeorge Prayer Letter February / March 2022

Dear praying friends,

Well Praise the Lord we have moved!

I'd be lying if it is said it wasn't a bumpy road along the way, but the Lord got us through! At the time of writing this letter we have been in the new house a week, we got our two 20ft shipping containers up here this past Wednesday and the great unpacking has begun...

We had to get a crane up to the old house this past Monday to get both our containers down on the road and accessible by side loader truck, all the cranes on the island we down, so Chek the Chinese construction company who is building Nauru's new port brought one of their cranes up to help us out. The crane and side load trucks cost us almost \$1500 and we are thankful for your financial support that enabled us to meet these needs. The scale on the crane told us that our two containers weighed a total of 11tons, which made me think that is not often during a move you get a metric tonnage weight to the stuff you accumulate through life and ministry at a particular location :)

The new house is liveable, but I'm still working on tiling the shower and getting the plumbing complete. It's not pretty, but we are getting there and making headway, slowly.

Church services at the community hall have worked well. Unfortunately during the move we lost a few families which was disappointing. We had two visitors our first two services at the new location, one of whom, James, has also come to Bible study and has a desire to learn the Word of God. He goes to Catholic Church Sunday morning and then comes to our morning service once he gets home on the bus. He has a mixed church background, please pray for his salvation.

We have had some issues with our old landlord regarding the move. We never had a lease agreement with the old house and came to find out that legally the custom here is that whatever gets attached to the house pretty much becomes the landlords when the renter moves out. This means the outside church bathroom and the church roofed area were both left behind and the church is out the \$13,500 that it spent to make those additions. We had hoped to meet face to face with our landlord to try work the situation out, but she would not meet and all our efforts to explain our case to her have fallen on deaf ears.

The bathroom was a concrete block construction and not very movable, but we had hoped to take down the church roof and reuse the materials at our new location, but we were unable to do so. I called my landlord's Pastor to visit her and plead our case but there had been no change. Would you pray for the Lord to work on Edina's heart and resolve the situation for us?

We are glad for the new house and new location, we just signed our 20yr lease for the house last night and are looking forward to a more certain future for our ministry and family.

The last few months have been hard on our family, our ministry and us physically, spiritually and emotionally. At times I've felt more like a construction worker than a pastor or missionary. Our boys have been a big help in preparing meals while we've been working and then working hard during the move. We feel we have been sustained by the Lord and your prayers on our behalf and pray that you would continue to lift us up before the throne in the days ahead.
