Dear Praying friends,

Thank you again for your prayers and support that enable us to keep on plodding away in the Lord's work in Nauru. We'd like to wish you a Merry Christmas from our family in Nauru to you as we approach the season for which Jesus is the reason :)

Visa Approval

We are thankful that we all have valid Nauruan visas in our passports again for another year. We had some delays due to expired passports, and waiting on new ones to arrive, but we were glad the Nauru Immigration office was sympathetic and understanding to our situation. Apparently after 14 years they were not looking for a reason to get rid of us :)

Visitors at Church

We have had a few visitors in the last few months. Ariel is a Taiwanese lady who stopped in at church on her Sunday morning bike ride. She is working at the Taiwanese Technical Mission and will return to Taiwan in the new year. She speaks English well and we hope she will respond to the Gospel before she leave Nauru for good.

We also had a family visit, Vaa and Loretta from Samoa, and 3 kids Deborah, Elam and Myles. Loretta is here on contract with the Government of Nauru. They also have a few more kids coming before Christmas. Please pray they would return to church and that we can be a help to them while they are here.

Thanksgiving in Nauru

While "Thanksgiving" is unique to North America, we have taken the occasion to remind our people that Giving Thanks is a Bible principal essential to Christian life from 1 Thessalonians 5:18 "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."

Instead of regular Bible study we each said something we were thankful for and had a fellowship dinner together. The following night we had a full house at Thanksgiving dinner with 11 friends from 5 countries! It was great food and enjoyable fellowship with all those who came.
