McGeorge Prayer Letter February/March 2025
Dear Praying Friends,

Well after 10,000 miles through 16 states, visiting almost 20 supporting churches we are off! We're thankful for safety on our travels and those who prayed that way for us.

February started cold in Ohio and finished in warm sunny Florida, where we were able to attend the GIBF meeting in Tampa, which was a real blessing, encouragement and challenge.

On our way back to Indiana from Florida Gideon got sick and we took him to the hospital only to find out it was his appendix. He had emergency laparoscopic surgery to remove his appendix at the children's hospital in Knoxville, Tennessee. We were thankful it happened in the USA in February, and not in Nauru in April.

March was spent getting ready to go, packing up some things to ship back to Nauru and being part of our home church. On Sunday March 2nd I was able to preach all day at our home church and one of the young men surrendered his life to be a Missionary! We Praise the Lord that He still wants to reach the uttermost parts of the earth with the Gospel and that He is still calling people to go where He chooses! Pray for Joe as follows the call to Missions.

Also in March the alternator died on our van, we were glad it was closer to home and we had people around to call on for help. Before we flew out we were able to attend the couples retreat with our home church and enjoy some time away without children :)

We said our goodbyes and flew to Australia, caught up with family, reported to a Church in Sydney, then drove 1000km to the Gold Coast to see more family and reported to two churches in Brisbane before flying back to Nauru.

New Video and New Possibilities

Our updated 2025 video presentation is up on the website, it's 7min long, and brings you up to date on the work in Nauru. Since we have Starlink satellite internet on the field we would be able to do a video call, or even make a virtual appearance during a service or missions conference.
