McGeorge Prayer Letter December/January 2026

Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for your prayers and support that enable us to serve the Lord in Nauru.

Out with the Old(2025), in with the New(2026)!

We had a great youth night Christmas Party at the boat harbor here with two floating trampolines, a tent to hang out under and hot dogs and marshmallows on the fire! Fun, food and fellowship was had by all who came! It was good to get James back after finishing his year 12 schooling on scholarship in Brisbane, Australia.

Christmas and New Years is a pretty quiet season on the island which we enjoyed. Things get more back to normal when school gets back in January and after Nauru's 58th Independence Day celebrations on 31st January.

We started a books of the Bible promotion in January and so far 5 people have said the all books of the Bible and claimed a prize for their effort.

Saul, our nurse from the Solomon Islands, who was Baptised in October 2025 received a ticket to go home to Rennell Island. He had been lonely and homesick during his time here, and we were sad to see him go, but we're glad to be a help to him while he was on Nauru, and we trust he will be faithful and a blessing to his church back home.

We had our annual business meeting on the 29th of January, which covered 2024 and 2025 as we were on furlough last January. We had a high of 36 in May 2025, had 20 visitors for the year and averaged 23.4 on Sundays and 6.42 for Bible Study. We had one saved, Andy, and 2 Baptised, Andy and Saul. We gave \$2,916.60 to missions for the year, and the church is doing well financially, and showing some growth in attendance and faithfulness. We certainly have not arrived, but we keep heading in the right direction!

Newer Vehicle Need Update

We are still raising funds to replace our 1995 Toyota Landcruiser with a newer vehicle. The cost of the a newer vehicle and shipping will be around \$35,000 USD. We have received 51% (18,000 USD) of the total need, Praise the Lord! If you consider helping to meet the remaining need, please do so via the GIBM and designate the funds for "Vehicle Replacement". We appreciate your help in meeting this need for us.
